









































































































Independent publishers operate on razor thin margins, and one way we can all help is by purchasing books directly from publishers or collectives like ABC. By

In 1985 a group of publishers met to address the constraints they were experiencing in marketing and distributing their books outside of their domestic markets.

They founded ABC as a collective self-help initiative to strengthen their economic base and meet the needs of libraries and other book buyers. With initial

support from funding agencies, trading began in 1989. Major remodeling of the collective took place in 2007, when it became self-financing. New opportunities

afforded by the evolution of digital publishing and electronic books were taken advantage of, with ABC playing a key role in the digitization of African cultural

output. While adapting to changing markets and methodologies, ABC's founding ethos and aims remain unchanged, and ABC remains a not-for-profit

organisation on its own behalf.
